Objectives:

1. Present the new Regional System of Educational Indicators (SRIE) with the preliminary results of the indicators for which information is already available.
2. Review the definitions of all the indicators that make up the SRIE, agreeing on calculation criteria for those with pending definitions.
3. Present the results of the first data quality assessments of the educational information systems carried out in 2018 and plan the implementation of these evaluations in 2019 in the countries that did not.
4. Analyze the characteristics of the household surveys in the region for the calculation of the SRIE educational indicators.
5. Start the discussion on the mechanism of data collection and information flows for the production and validation of the SRIE indicators.
